From Monday 14 May, students from group 7 will participate in the Entrance Test. Normally, the Entrance Exams are taken within a period of 3 to 4 days, as a result of which pupils become exhausted and can no longer concentrate properly, affecting the result.

Because we know our students well and we want to use their capacities optimally, we do it differently. Our children will make the Entrance Orders over periods of 3 weeks. They get a part every day and therefore have enough time, space and energy for other things. In addition to the Entrance Test, we will also conduct an intelligence test. The results of the intelligence test will provide more insight into what a pupil really can do! Together with the previously achieved school results, a preliminary advice will then follow.

Parent contribution FREE with the city pass

He Does your child have a City Pass? Then the parental contribution with the Stadspas is free. The budget coach (Djemilla Haps) of MaDi Foundation supports you with the application. Djemilla is at school every Thursday from 13.30 - 15.30. On Thursday 19 April she will be present in the morning from 08:00-10:00. The budget coach of MaDi will scan the City Pass of your child for the application of the parental contribution. This scan is sent to the municipality. The municipality then ensures that the amount for the parental contribution, including the school trip, is paid into the school's account.

Hereby the request to pay the payment as soon as possible so that we can continue to give shape to the activities of the children. The parental contribution is 50 euros and can be transferred to account number NL64INGB0005819450. Foundation Parents Council De Blauwe Lijn in Amsterdam. For the multi-day school trip of group 8, the costs are 125 euros, the parents of group 8 have received a separate bill.
