OUTING TO HORTUS

On Monday, June 24, groups 4a and 4 / 5b go to hortus, Wednesday, June 26, groups 5a and 6a go and Thursday, June 27, groups 6 / 7b go to Hortus.

During their visit they get a treasure hunt in which they can learn everything about plants and nutrition.

Each group receives a shopping basket with 10 products and searches for the corresponding plants in the garden and greenhouses: banana, coffee, bamboo, apple, cocoa, rice, fig, kitchen spices, cinnamon and rubber. A few questions are answered for each plant, such as: which part of the plant is used and which climate does this plant like?
