Of course we want to keep you as a parent informed at all times about the content that is discussed with your children during the training. That is why we are holding a third information evening for all parents of group 7 on De Blauwe Lijn on **Tuesday 17 September 2019 from 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm**.

We take into account that you come from work or elsewhere and will therefore serve snacks and drinks.

Het Huis is a preventative approach specifically developed for children between the ages of 8 and 16. In the approach that focuses on the awareness and resilience of these children, self-esteem, responsibility and learning to make the right choices are central. Het Huis takes into account the cultural environment in which children grow up. Factors such as socialization, but also the influence of school, the neighborhood and the social and socio-economic position of these children and their families play an important role here. Het Huis has a deeper meaning and is therefore used as a metaphor for our approach. Just like every house, the approach has a solid foundation (identity), walls to hold the whole upright (norms & values) and a roof that offers both mental and physical protection (self-determination).

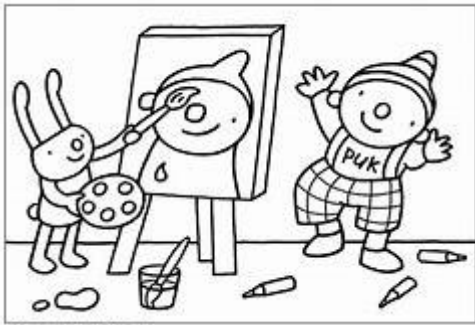
Last week we started with the theme Welcome PUK!

The children learn to explore the corners in a playful way and the game material. For example, where do you clear the blocks, Where can you find a puzzle or a game. The day rhythm cards are repeated every day in the circle. The teachers take care of this theme for structure and rules within the group.

The parent consultant will shortly present the theme books and a theme meeting Organize the theme for parents.

Monday 23 September we will start with the theme "I am an artist"

Everything in this theme focuses on art. It is about discovering art and the children's own creativity. Creativity appeals to the senses and when performing a creative expression it appeals to the motor. It also appeals to social-emotional development: I like what I like. With art that is allowed. The children explore materials, colors and shapes.



The theme "I am an artist" is in line with the perception of the child. Discovering and wondering for the environment is an important aspect.

This theme starts with the children themselves: what do I look like, how can I move and stand still like a statue, what positions can I adopt.

Materials are explored such as statuettes in all possible forms and of all kinds of materials. But plastic materials such as dough / clay, paste and paint are also covered.

Not the result, but the process is central to the activities.
