VALENCIA STUDY TRIP

During the autumn holidays we went on a study trip to Valencia (Spain) with a part of our team.

During our trip we were able to visit no less than 7 different schools.

We were warmly welcomed and were able to see how citizenship is shaped within Spanish education. We have consciously opted for diversity in schools, for example, we went to a kindergarten, primary schools in deprived areas, primary schools in middle-class economics but also high schools. We were able to see and learn a lot from Spanish education and were able to share our knowledge with them. In some schools, many similarities could be seen with, for example, our kanjer training. There were also schools that also had a student council or even mediators. Through E-twinning (an online communication platform from the Erasmus university) we hope to stay in touch with these schools. The goal is to eventually bring our students into contact with each other internationally. In this way they get to know the norms, values and customs from different cultures, so that they also get to understand each other better. Of course before then we would ask for your permission!

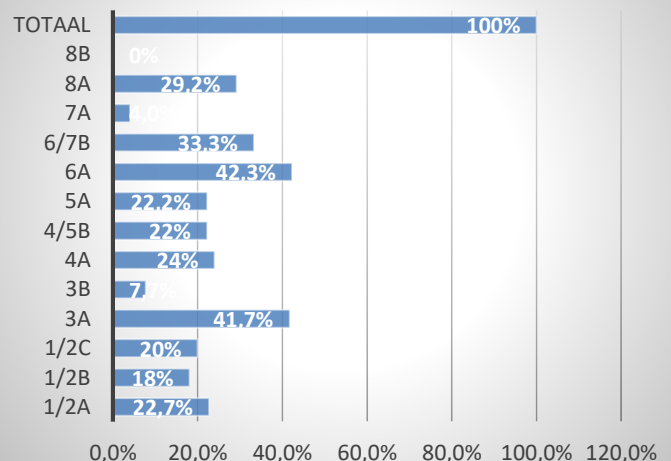
PARENT CONTRIBUTION AND CITY PASS

We think our students are important, don't you? Therefore do not miss any information and activate your FIEP account!

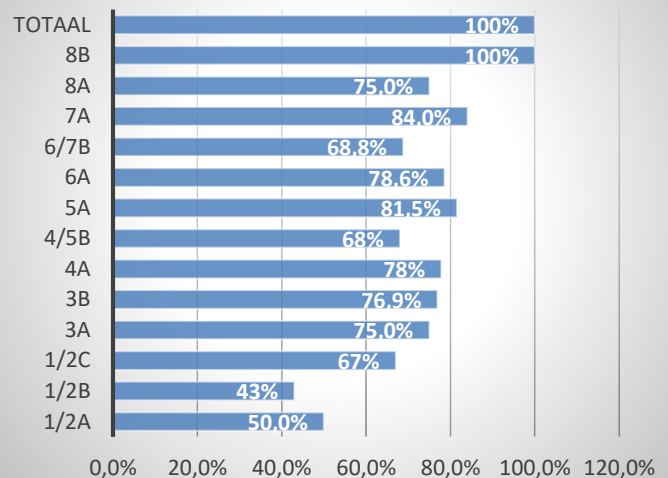
Step 1: Download the Fiep app on your phone via the App store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android).
