SCHOOL IS OPEN AGAIN ON THE 8TH OF JUNE

Starting Monday 8 June, all children can go to school at the same time again. It is nice that we can now finish the school year together. The measures taken at school continue to apply and must be followed.

To avoid crowds and group formation, we will be at school from 8.00 in the schoolyard to welcome our students. We ask that you bring your children to school before 8.15.

It is very important that you, as a parent, do not wait in front of the fence. As soon as you hand over your child, continue in one-way traffic. Arrows will indicate where you must go. You are not allowed to enter the schoolyard and we ask you to please keep the 1.5-meter distance.

Due to the activities in front of the schoolyard, we ask you to please come by foot or bike and to avoid having to park as much as possible. If this is not an option, please park further away, there is a temporary parking lot of the Henriette Roland Holsthuis. Follow the one-way traffic, do not turn, follow the signs for the exit from the parking lot of the Henriette Roland Holsthuis.



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SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHER

The school photographer will come to school on Friday the 5th of June! We are happy that our students can be photographed despite the corona virus. Of course, we will be doing this carefully and according to the measures given by the RIVM.

The B group will be photographed first. On this day, the portrait photos and sibling pictures will be taken. PLEASE NOTE: only siblings that go to school at the Blauwe Lijn can be photographed, this is possible between 14.15 and 15.15.

On Monday, June 8th, school will open fully again. On this day, the other children will take portrait photos, sibling pictures will also be taken and so will the group pictures.

PLEASE NOTE: the children who will be photographed on Friday will be photographed again on Monday for group pictures. Sibling pictures on Monday will be from 13.00-14.15 (can be extended)

Depending on the weather forecast, we expect the pictures can be taken outside. Like every year, our Blauwe Bijtjes will be photographed first, followed by lower grades and then the higher grades. The portrait and class pictures are taken during school hours, the sibling pictures can run until 15.15.

Our parent council will organize the day as usual. They also adhere to the precautions of RIVM and are allowed to enter the schoolyard with exception.

SCHOOL SWIMMING LESSONS

From June 8, school swimming is organized by school again, this only applies to students who have received a letter. It is important that these students wear swimsuits under their normal clothes. The other students will remain at school with a teacher. It would be great if you could pick up your swimming children at the pool.

HANDING IN YOUR DEVICES

The Blauwe Lijn will open entirely again, which means that the devices that were issued on loan are no longer necessary because there will be no more online education. We ask everyone that has received one or more devices from school to return them to us. Do this in the following way: Write down the name and group of your child on a piece of paper and put them together with the device and all accompanying accessories in a plastic bag and tie it shut tightly.

If you have borrowed multiple devices, do this separately for every device. You can hand them in with your child's teacher.
