That is why we have set up a campaign together with SSV Amsterdam to hold a 1-hour corona lesson every day for students who are in quarantine at home.

It is very important that the students also come online at the agreed time, the teachers of SSV can help them to complete the assignments according to the weekly task.

The municipality of Amsterdam tries to support these families, parents can register with the Youth Education Fund to pay for the financing for extra support. Reading letters and words in core 4

The new letters in core 4 are: w, o, a, u, j. In the previous kern, the children were already given the opportunity to write words such as 'spaar' and 'vrij' in addition to words such as 'doek' and 'ijs'. ' to read. It is not a problem if your child still finds it difficult. These words are not yet part of the basic material. However, your child can already read "stam + t" such as "vaart" and "rent", but not yet "rijdt" or "wordt"
