Lights are on and everywhere in the classrooms


you can find decorated trees. The School is beautifully

12x late compulsory education receives absenteeism report (including absenteeism state and school effort) and calls pupil / parents and / or guardian for questioning

Compulsory education draws up an official report and sends it to parents and / or guardians and school.

Meanwhile, the parent council has incurred costs for the Sinterklaas and Christmas party.


It is nice to see that the city passes are already coming in. Don't forget to have your child's city pass scanned with us
