Last Thursday 11 March 2021 we had to send home two classes due to a positively tested student and a sister that could also be infected. Agreements below are thus very important!
Parents from the concerned groups have since received a letter about this.

CORONA AGREEMENTS

- If your child has a cold or fever, you keep your child at home.
Your child can come back to school if he/she has experienced no complaints in the last two days or has a negative test.
- If someone in the group is infected, the entire group must stay home for 5 days.
The children can come back after 5 days if they have no complaints, they can come back sooner if they have a negative test.
- As a parent or other family member over 12 years old, do you have corona-related complaints? Keep your child at home until you are free of complaints for 2 days or can hand over a negative test.
- Students that are stuck at home due to corona will receive online education.
- Someone tested positive for corona in the household? Stay inside and follow the GGD guidelines.

ALL-IN-1 TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT WEEK 3 AND 4

Maybe you have seen it Monday morning the 8th of March. We started the theme Traffic and Transport. We placed a road in the school yard with crossings and different traffic signs. The teachers were dressed as traffic wardens. This was a fun sight. The children will be working on this theme from the 8th of March onwards.

The children learn, on their own level, all about traffic and transport.

Week 2 Info: Traffic on the road

There are different types of roads.

Highways are placed on behalf of the government.

You can recognize highways by the letter A in their road numbers, like the A7.

A lot of these highways have an E number.

Then this road is an important European road.

Provinces take care of provincial roads.

In front of the road numbers you'll see the letter N, like N337.

Municipalities also place roads through cities and villages.

The municipality takes care of these.

Week 4 Info: Trains, trams and metro

After the steam trains, there were the diesel trains. Most trains run on electricity. They get electricity through the pipes. Trains go over rails made of steel. Below the steel you'll find concrete. There are different types of passenger trains.

Stop trains go over short tracks and stop at different stations. Sprinters are stop trains that can go very fast, but can also stop quickly. Intercities only stop at big stations. Double-decker trains have two floors. International trains go abroad. High-speed train scan go faster than 300 kilometers an hour. A tram goes through town over rails. In Amsterdam and Rotterdam you can travel by metro. Metro rails can be found below the city mostly. In this theme you will also learn songs and we will practice with the rules.

Think of applying for a sports and culture fund.

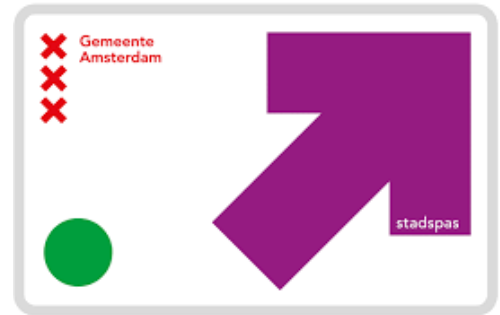
You can also ask Djemilla questions about facilities / allowances that are available from the Municipality, to request a laptop or in the field of finances.
