Word types in core 11

The new word types that the children learn to read in core 11 are:

- two syllable words ending in -ig or -lijk, such as: safe and fair;
- two-syllable words ending in -ing, such as: bend;
- compound words of three syllables, such as: picture book and wrapping;
- diminutives of three syllables ending in -je, -pje or -tje, such as: reading booklet, broom and apple;
- words of two or three syllables that start with thunder or thunder, such as: thunderstorm and breakfast;
- three syllable words that begin with verb, verb, or verb, such as: mean, dangers, and tell.

ALLES-IN-1 THEME ANIMALS "BIRDS "

Birds are vertebrates.

They are the only animals with feathers.

Feathers protect the animals against water and cold.

There are down feathers under the feathers.

The down retains the heat.

The feathers of females often have a camouflage color.

Each bird species has a different beak: long and short beaks, straight and curved beaks, pointed beaks, spoon beaks, ...

The beak is just right for the food the bird is looking for.

It's his tool.

Birds lay eggs in a nest.

In most bird species, the female incubates the eggs.

Many birds travel in spring and autumn.

That is called bird migration.

The birds fly in the fall to places where they have a lot of food can find.

In the spring they return to breed and raise their young.

Special birds:

- The largest bird is the ostrich (120 kilos).
- The fastest bird (300 km / h) is the peregrine falcon.
- The Giant Albatross has the longest wings (3.5 meters).
- The smallest bird in the world is the bee hummingbird (5.5 cm)
