Drink	Water, tea without sugar or milk
10 h snack	Fruit/ veggies possibly with a whole wheat sandwich
Lunch	Whole wheat sandwich, veggies/fruit
Treat	Veggies or fruit or 1 other treat

If a student regularly brings unhealthy snacks from home, we will send it back home with a note to the parent. The student can get a piece of fruit or bread from the school's 'emergency supply'.

FLEXIBLE EDUCATION TIMES

From 1 August 2020, The Blauwe Lijn will be participating in a pilot with the flexible scheduling and organization of teaching time. We may deviate from the normal holidays.

What does this mean for students/parents of the Blauwe Lijn?

Students are welcome on the Blauwe Lijn for 46 weeks a year. The Blauwe Lijn will be closed for 2 weeks at Christmas, from December 21, 2020 to January 3, 2021 and 4 weeks during the summer holidays, July 19, 2021 to August 13, 2021.

The other breaks may be taken flexibly. It is possible for the students to take a fall / spring / May break at a time or to take a day off from time to time.

Fall break?

The Blauwe Lijn is open during the fall break. Your child can go to school all week, it is also possible to come to school for 1, 2, 3 or 4 days. We would like to hear from you before October 1st. whether your child will be coming to school during the fall break (and on which days). You can pass this on to the teacher or the children can indicate this in the class on a registration list.

COVID-19 UPDATES

This means, among other things, that both pupils and teachers stay at home with a cold and fever. Teachers with complaints are tested and therefore have to stay home sick more often than you are used to. Fortunately, we have almost no teacher drop-out and can still deal with this internally if this does happen.

However, situations may arise where this does not work, and the children of the relevant group must stay at home. We hope for your understanding.

We will of course keep a close eye on developments and remain in close contact with the municipality and the GGD about the measures. If you have any questions about this letter and the corona measures, you can always contact us.

Let's try our best together to keep the Covid-19 infection rates as small as possible. We would like to thank you very much for your cooperation in the past weeks and we hope that we can return to 'normal' education soon.

PARENT CONTRIBUTION AND CITY PASSES

This school year we will again participate in the pilot "free parental contribution with a city pass"! Does your child have a City pass? Then the parental contribution and school trip with the City pass are free. Our budget consultant Djemilla Haps of the MaDi foundation will be present again from next week on, every Thursday at 13:45! Because parents are not yet allowed to go to school, she will be outside for questions. You can make an appointment with her for things like the sports and culture fund. You can also have the city pass scanned with her or Anissa (office manager). This scan is sent to the municipality. The municipality then ensures that the amount for the parental contribution is deposited into the account of the school.

If you do not have a city pass?

Due to the corona crisis we did not go on a school trip last school year, the parent council will use the paid contribution to organize other activities for the children. The justification of the parental contribution is reflected in the participation council. The parent council will therefore draw up a budget on how they will spend these funds on behalf of the children.

At the moment the parent council is busy with cooking together with the students.
