SAFE LEARNING TO READ CORE 5 "WHERE DO YOU LIVE?"

The main role in the story of this core, "Then you don't know Krisje Kolen!", is for Krisje Kolen. Krisje Kolen likes it when everything is neat and tidy; not even a blade of grass is wrong on his lawn. He tries to keep it that way with all kinds of signs that state what is not allowed around his house. This story is an opportunity to talk about rules. What is allowed, what is not allowed, what happens if you don't obey the rules? Words such as "the crook", "the fine", "the rule" and "the uniform" are discussed.

Reading letters and words in core 5:

The new letters in core 5 are: eu, ie, l, ou and uu. For some children, the "eu", "ie" and "ou" are quite difficult. We therefore pay a lot of attention to those letters and repeat them every day.
